

The governance of the institution is reflective:

The governing council of the institution consists of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Karnatak University, Dharwad as a Chairman, Registrar of the University, one Syndicate member, two Senior Associate Professors and one senior Assistant Professor as members, and the Principal of the College as Secretary. The Principal monitors the system regarding administration and academic process. The governing council ensures proper functioning of the policies, rules and action-plans of the college. There are several bodies / committees, which have been constituted in order to support the vision and mission of the college. The various bodies / committees are NSS, NCC, Career and counseling cell, anti-ragging cell, library and gymkhana, cultural and youth festival, internal examination, college miscellany, Admission, UGC , disciplinary, scholarship, grievances and redressal committees, among many others etc.

The Chairmans and members of the different committees responsibility for the plans and activities under their care, and successfully tackle these responsibilities in every academic session. For monitoring the academic activities, meetings with HOD's and faculty members of various departments are regularly conducted and necessary suggestions are given. Also, the progress of completed teaching work is assessed monthly by monitoring the teacher's work dairy. Principal continuously monitors the teaching - learning activities in each class room and laboratories by visiting and observing the same through CCTV and also watching the movement of the students in the campus. The financial requirements are proposed by various committees and the Principal or the Governing Council committee approves it.

Discipline and Anti-Ragging Cell:

- Mentoring teachers and other staff.

According to the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India- "Ragging is any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness to any student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which cause or likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment to adversely affect the psyche of a fresher or a junior student."

To ensure a completely ragging-free environment on the campus and in compliance with the letter from UGC, an Anti-Ragging Cell has been constituted in the college campus. Anti Ragging Cell conveners and its members are working to maintain and preserving the culture of "Ragging Free Environment" in the college campus.


