7.1.8 - Describe the Institutional efforts/initiatives in providing an inclusive environment i.e., tolerance and harmony towards cultural, regional, linguistic, communal socioeconomic and other diversities.

The institute upholds its visions and shows the tolerance and harmony towards cultural, regional, linguistic, communal, socio-economic and other diversities.

Cultural events: The institute organizes cultural programs under the banner of Gymkhana to promote students talent and appreciate the cultural diversity of India. The institute offers courses in specific subjects which are rare in Indian academy: Anthropology, Forensic Science and Criminology offered in the Under-graduate level attracts the students from all over the country. Hence, students from various states and regional and cultural backgrounds generally participate in cultural programs and represent their geographical/regional culture.
