# 3.4.1 - Extension activities are carried out in the neighbourhood community, sensitizing students to social issues, for their holistic development, and impact thereof during the year.

The NSS and NCC units of Karnatak Science College, Dharwad (KSCD) have actively conducted various activities in the campus as well as outside the campus to sensitize students towards social issues, for their holistic development.

**Anti -Tobacco Day** was conducted by the NSS volunteers of Karnatak Science College Dharwad on 04-06-2022. This special day was dedicated to spreading awareness about the harmful effects of tobacco and its addictive nature. On this occasion, various events and activities were organized throughout the day in order to educate and engage individuals with the aim of promoting a tobacco free society. Fifty NSS volunteers actively participated to make this program a success.

**World Environment Day:** World Environment Day was observed in the college by conducting "plantation programmes" on 03-06-2022 and 05-06-2022, which involved the planting of 100 plants both within and outside the campus. This program involved the participation of sixty NSS volunteers and staff-members of the college.

Celebration Of World Diabetes Day(Walkthon): On account of World Diabetes Day (on 14<sup>th</sup> November, 2022), the Karnataka Science College NSS unit in association with Rotary club and the health department at Dharwad was celebrated World Diabetes Days on 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> November 2022. The Jatha or procession started from the college campus up to Kalabhavan and thereafter, the procession moved towards the market area of Dharwad city. In this program, 90 NSS volunteers, 10 rotary club members and 6 health Department Staff participated.

**Voters Awareness Jatha:** Voters Awareness Programme was arranged on 04-05-2022 in the College Campus, as well as outside the campus to spread the message of the power of

"democracy in action" by casting their Vote. In this Jatha, 50 Volunteers and staff of the college were present.

Seven Days NSS Camp at Marewad: The NSS unit of Karnatak Science College, Dharwad arranged a NSS program for seven days, from 17/02/2023 to 23/02/2023, in a village (Marewad). In this camp, 50 NSS Volunteers<sup>2</sup> participated in order to sensitize students to social issues such as health and hygiene, environment, cultural identity, education, women safety, and child labor. On the first day of the NSS camp, the volunteers invited the villagers to the camp and trained them about the importance of greenery for breathing oxygen rich air, and to spread awareness about the use of plastics and their harmful effects. On the second day, the NSS volunteers reached every door step in the village and made them aware about the declining sex ratio due to girl child aversion. On the third day of the camp, "shramadaan" activities such as cleaning the main streets of the village, and drainage cleaning were taken up, and the villagers were advised to avoid open defecation. On the fourth day of the NSS camp, an awareness program about environmental pollution and its prevention was organized. On the fifth day, special attention was given to awareness and discussion about human values, ethics and motivation to "live for the nation and die for the nation" among the village people. In fact, opportunities were provided to the local people, for their active participation in the same. On the sixth day of the NSS camp, a tobacco free drive and blood donation drive were organized. On the seventh day of the camp, awareness programme of about governments schemes such as "pradhan mantri awas "krishi arranya prosthaha yojana", and "shramashakti loan scheme" was organized.







#### SEVEN DAYS NSS CAMP AT MAREWAD


