The institution consistently embraces decentralization and participative management practices, fostering quality enhancement across various levels – Administrative, Management, Governing Council, Principal, IQAC, Various committees, non-teaching Staff, NCC & NSS coordinators, and all other stakeholders involved.

Management: The College Management Committee comprises the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Registrar, Syndicate, Academic Council, Principal, Heads of departments, Teaching and Non-teaching staff.
