The Principal monitors the mechanism regarding administration and academic process. The governing council ensures proper functioning of the policies, rules and action-plans of the college. 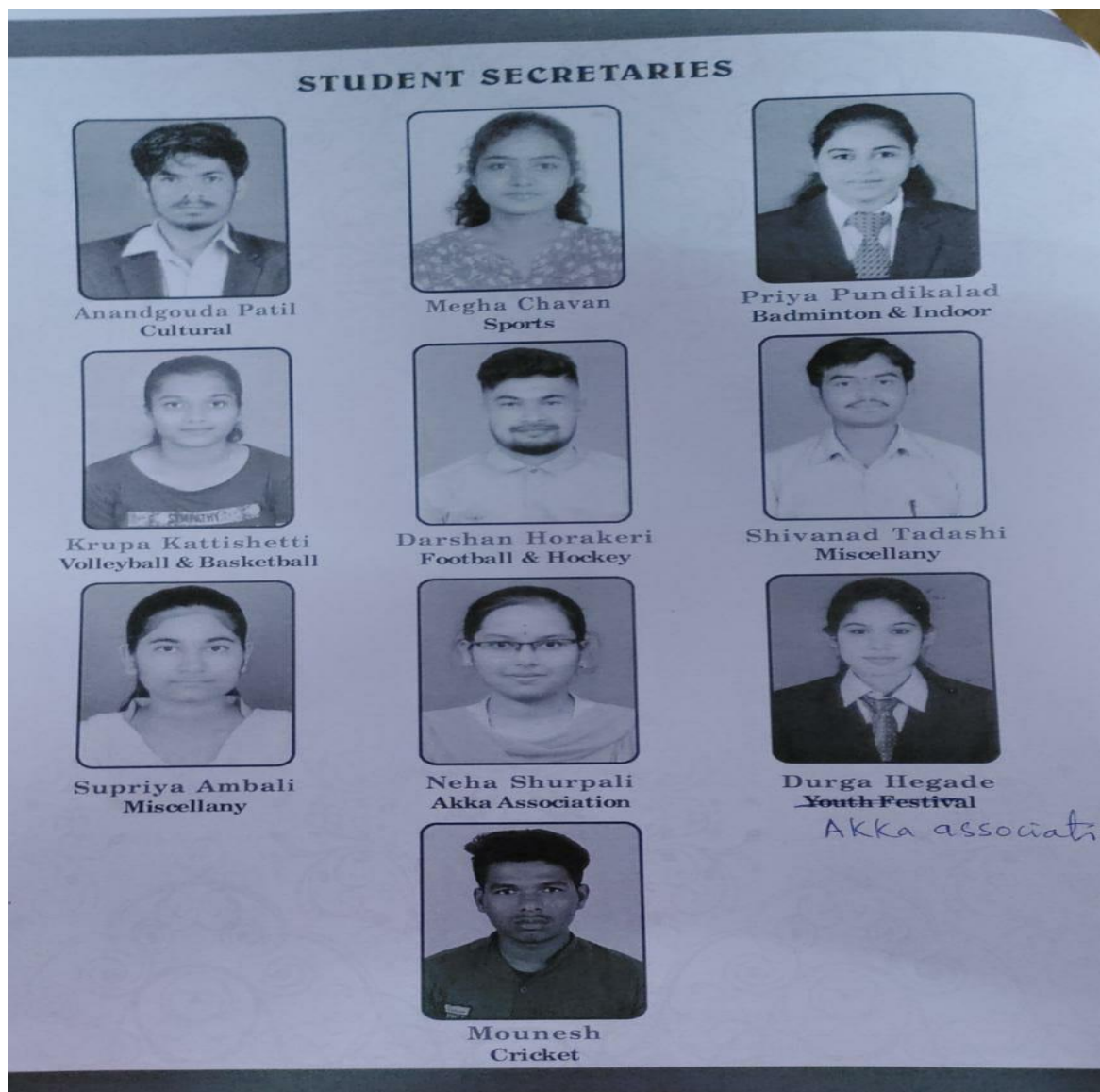
