## Miscellany

The Karnatak College has the tradition of publishing the "Miscellany -A college Magazine from its inception in 1917. It was then an important forum having a Professor of Language to work as Chairman or Chief Editor of the magazine and it was publishing the articles, poems written by students, reports of activities and also recording important state and national events. In the beginning two editions were published in one academic year and later it only one edition was brought out. When Karnatak Science College got independent existence as a result of bifurcation the college gymkhana also newly formed. The Karnatak Arts college Miscellany is named as "Ninaad" and Karantak Science College Miscellany is named as "Varnasaptak".

The students are also encouraged to write the articles, scientific papers, on different topics related to science, literature, humanity, in many languages, stories, poems for inclusion in the college miscellany 'Varnasaptaka' every year. It also contains reports of various cultural and sports activities, curricular, co curricular and extra-curricular activities along with photographs, drawings, sketches and speeches of Principal on the occasion of Independence Day and Republic Day celebrations and messages of eminent personalities.

The department of Miscellany has a chairperson as a Chief Editor of Varnasaptaka (permanent faculty of the college) and a student secretary as student editor (mostly from degree final year) and editorial board having representatives from all the departments. The selection of the student secretary is done purely on merit basis or competition conducted according to the laws of gymkhana.
